# 4. REPORTS OF OFFICERS

**Financial Update:** The Board was able to set aside money from 2019, combined with a projected positive cash flow in 2020, to implement a significant number of improvements. The 2019 results included the cost of 3 initiatives—Griffin Park tree trimming, the cost of a new keycard system for the clubhouse and pool, and Christmas lights along Griffin Park Blvd.

We showed a breakout of how a resident's dues helps support the various expense categories in the neighborhood.

With regard to 2020 improvements, the largest expense was the re-paving of the walking trail. With some maintenance every 2-4 years this trail should be able to last the neighborhood a long time. Also the Board is pleased that we have been able to set aside a reserve fund which currently sits at \$10,000. This fund will help in the event of a major, unexpected expense like the pool equipment, the clubhouse air conditioner, or a roof issue, for example.
